May 7, 2013: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE INSTALLATION, REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF THE ASPHALT ROAD SURFACE ON DAHLIA STREET, BIRCH STREET AND WINWOOD DRIVE

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village ("City") is authorized pursuant to Article IX of the Home Rule Charter to adopt a budget and to make supplemental appropriations by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to complete repaving of certain streets which has become necessary due to utility excavation and construction; and

WHEREAS, City Council has approved the paving of Winwood Drive as outlined in the City's Street Paving Policy; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements outlined in the City's Construction and Excavation Standards and agreed to in the correspondence from Denver Water representatives dated April 9, 2013, the total cost of the repaving project on Birch and Dahlia Streets will be reimbursed to the City by the Denver Water Board; and

WHEREAS, the homeowners of Winwood Drive have agreed to pay for the paving of the road and specific other costs associated with paving operations; and

WHEREAS, these projects are important to the City's transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to complete this project in 2013, but the expenditures were not included in the 2013 budget; and

WHEREAS, performing these operations at this time is necessary to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the City's residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve a supplemental appropriation to the 2013 Budget in the amounts and for the reasons set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the 2013 Budget and Appropriations be hereby supplemented by increasing the following funds and accounts, to-wit:
