April 9, 2012: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed by a vote of 4 yes and 0 no.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, **AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR ADDITIONAL LITIGATION EXPENSES IN FISCAL YEAR 2012**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village has incurred additional expenses related to unforeseen litigation matters; and

WHEREAS, these expenses related to litigation are in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00); and

WHEREAS, these expenses were not budgeted for in the 2012 budget; and

WHEREAS, the March 20, 2012 City Council meeting is the first opportunity the Council has had to approve a supplemental appropriation. Recognizing that this ordinance approving the supplemental appropriation will not technically become effective until after passage of second reading at the Council's first meeting in April, City Council directs staff to make the required payments in March, 2012.
