

**ORDINANCE NO. 06  
Series 2008**

February 19, 2008: Introduced as Council Bill 2, Series 2008 by Councilmember Harriet LaMair, seconded by Councilmember Klasina VanderWerf, and considered by the title only on first reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

March 18, 2008: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE,  
AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008**

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2007, Catherine Anderson conveyed the Anderson Property (subject to a conservation easement and a reserved life estate) to the City of Cherry Hills Village by way of a Special Warranty Deed; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution 2, Series 2008, this Council accepted the donation of certain real property known as the "Catherine Anderson Property"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council had agreed in discussions with The Conservation Fund and Colorado Open Lands to reimburse the costs incurred by these organizations associated with property acquisition and the completion of a Conservation Easement on the Catherine Anderson Property, and the conveyance of the land to Cherry Hills Village; and

WHEREAS, a summary of these costs for the Catherine Anderson Property have been submitted to the City; and

WHEREAS, these funds had not been appropriated in the 2008 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:


Section 1. That the 2008 Budget and Appropriations be hereby supplemented by increasing the following funds and accounts, to-wit:

Arapahoe County Open Space Fund 14  
As determined on or before December 31, 2008



Section 2. The City Council hereby ratifies all expenditures heretofore and hereafter made pursuant to this supplemental appropriation ordinance.


