ROLL CALL

Commission members in attendance: Ann Polumbus, Gay Warren, Teresa Harbaugh, Douglas Smooke, Councilor VanderWerf. Employees present: Karen Proctor, Director of Finance, Pamela Broyles, Administrative Assistant.

CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Polumbus called the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

There was no audience participation.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ms. Gay Warren moved to approve the August 27, 2012 minutes. Mr. Doug Smooke seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

a. Article for the Village Crier

Ms. Harbaugh will write an article for the Village Crier including information on the Rady Art Auction.

b. Landscaping for Sundown Sculpture

The Commission discussed extending the existing landscaping so it surrounds the Sundown Sculpture.

Ms. Polumbus met with Jay Goldie regarding the plan and he estimated the changes would cost up to \$1,400.00.

Councilor VanderWerf moved to approve funds up to \$1,400.00 to add landscaping around the Sundown sculpture. Ms. Gay Warren Seconded the Motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Smooke also reviewed Tricia Robson's comments with the Commission.

Mr. Smooke announced that Anthony Heinz May is the unanimous top choice among the Commission and Reven Swanson's "flying trees" was the second choice.

The Commission discussed the need to determine a location for the art pieces and how to move forward with contacting the artists. The Commission agreed that the artists should have the opportunity to visit the different locations.

Mr. Smooke agreed to contact both artists to discuss their needs and specifications. He will question expenses and a timeline to complete the art piece. The Commission agreed that Woodie Hollow Park may be a good choice for the tree sculpting.

The Commission would like to finalize the two art pieces before the end of the year.

The Commission also liked local artist Georgene McGonagle's work and they discussed possible locations for her sculpture of birds. The Commission would first need to determine if the artist is willing to make something of appropriate size with the understanding it would be on loan. The Commission also suggested that one of her smaller sculptures could be considered for the new public safety facility.

New Sculpture

Ms. Polumbus presented a sculpture that could be created life size and possibly donated to the City. She requested feedback on whether the Commission would be interested in the piece.

The Commission agreed they like the sculpture, but they would need more information such as size, location and whether it would be a donation before making any commitment.

Budget

Councilor VanderWerf reported that City Council is starting to go through the budget process and the Art Commission needs to think about how many installations they want to do next year and the estimated cost. She said she believes the same amount that was budgeted in 2012 will be budgeted in 2013.

Ms. Proctor reported that she will look into carrying over the unused funds from 2012 into 2013.

Mr. Smooke reported that the Museum of Contemporary Art Denver (MCA) is holding their annual gala on October 25th and tables are available if the Commission is interested. The event will host a live auction and a silent auction.

ADJOURNMENT


There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:38 a.m. The next Art Commission meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 22, 2012.
