**ROLL CALL**

Commission members in attendance: Ann Polumbus, Douglas Smooke, Teresa Harbaugh, Councilor VanderWerf. Employees present: Karen Proctor, Director of Finance, Pamela Broyles, Administrative Assistant.

Absent: Gay Warren

**CALL TO ORDER**

Ms. Polumbus called the meeting to order at 8:33 a.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Ms. Teresa Harbaugh moved to approve the January 28, 2013 minutes as amended. Councilor Klasina VanderWerf seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

**AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION**

There was no audience participation.

**OLD BUSINESS****a. Discussion of Reven Swanson Sculpture**

Mr. Smooke reported that he attended City Council with Reven Swanson to present the proposed art sculpture for approval. City Council approved installing the art piece at the proposed location of Quincy and Happy Canyon.

**b. Crier Article Assignment**

Mr. Smooke will write the next Crier article.

Ms. Polumbus pointed out that it is important to stress that the art pieces displayed in the Community are for sale. She noted that Anthony Heinz May received a Commission from a local resident and suggested that this could also be used to market other artists.

**c. Plaque for Anthony Heinz May Sculpture**

Ms. Broyles reported that a boulder and plaque have been installed in Three Pond Park next to the Anthony Heinz May sculpture.

**d. Photo Wall of Artists**

Ms. Polumbus asked for ideas on where to place a photo wall to display a picture of each piece of art that is donated or loaned to the City. The Commission discussed options and agreed that Ann Polumbus and Teresa Harbaugh will work on the photo wall and report back to the Commission at the next meeting. Ms. Harbaugh shared that she may be able to help with framing the photos.

**NEW BUSINESS****a. Establish Criteria for Art in the New Public Safety Facility**

Ms. Polumbus presented a sample of a criteria sheet she drafted to be used for future art pieces. She asked the Commission for input.

Ms. Harbaugh suggested adding that this is a horse friendly community.

The Commission previously discussed having temporary art from local artists and schools and suggested that they may need to have some additional guidelines for these pieces. The Commission agreed not to be too restrictive as to exclude potential artists. The group discussed including guidelines such as not excluding private property and adding criteria to describe how the artists are chosen.

Mr. Smooke agreed to contact some of his acquaintances in Denver to get some ideas of what their criteria looks like.

Councilor VanderWerf and Mr. Smooke agreed to work on finalizing the criteria sheet.

The Commission asked staff to establish a criteria list for using the Community Room in the Public Safety Facility.

**b. 2013 Calendar of Events**

The Commission discussed holding an event this summer as a fundraiser for the Art Commission. The Commission would like to invite a resident with a nice art collection to host the event in their home. There was also discussion on options for catering the event. The Commission agreed to contact a few residents and Ann Polumbus and Councilor VanderWerf will give a report to the Art Commission at the next meeting.

**c. Discussion on Artist Duke Beardsley**



Ms. Harbaugh asked if the Commission has considered the sculpture pieces that she presented to be on loan and displayed in the new Public Safety Facility building.



**ADJOURNMENT**


There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:10 a.m. The next Art Commission meeting is scheduled for March 25, 2013.
