### **ROLL CALL**

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

### **OLD BUSINESS – Flag Advertising Art Show**

The Commission discussed possibilities for a flag or sign to advertise the presence of art shows at the Joint Public Safety Facility with Chief Tovrea. The Commission decided to discuss the matter further at the next meeting.

### **COLLIN PARSON, ARVADA CENTER ART CURATOR**

Collin Parson of the Arvada Center presented information on Colorado sculptors. He advised the Commission on types of outdoor sculptures, acquisition options, maintenance, and funding. The Commission also discussed public input and notification methods with Mr. Parsons.

### **OLD BUSINESS – Peter Roosevelt Show**

Chair Polumbus reviewed the plan for the Peter Roosevelt Art Show reception.

### **OLD BUSINESS – Crier Article**

The Commission discussed how to solicit artists to have art shows in the Community Room at the Joint Public Safety Facility, how often to have art shows, and how independent the art shows should be from the Commission.

Commissioner Warren indicated that she would donate one of her paintings to the City to be displayed in the Joint Public Safety Facility.

**NEW BUSINESS – Process for Selection**

Councilor VanderWerf explained that a resident had attended the last Council meeting and had asked that residents be notified when installation of a piece of art or a park improvement was being considered near their property.

Chair Polumbus indicated that she would attend tomorrow's Council meeting to present the Chainsaw sculpture for installation at Dahlia Hollow Park, and would also address the issue of public notice at the meeting.

Commissioner Doug Smooke left at 9:55 a.m.

The Commission discussed public notice of art installation.


**ADJOURNMENT**

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:55 a.m.


The next Art Commission meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 27, 2014.
