October 21, 2008: Introduced as Council Bill 21, Series 2008 by Councilmember LaMair, seconded by Councilmember Griffin, and considered by the title only on first reading. Passed by a vote of 5 yes and 0 no.

November 4, 2008: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed by a vote of 4 yes and 0 no.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE,
AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
FOR THE REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF
SANITARY SEWER LINES
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village owns and operates sanitary sewer lines that transverse the Cherry Hills Village Country Club property; and

WHEREAS, these sanitary sewer lines are in need of repair and replacement; and

WHEREAS, The Cherry Hills Village Country Club is performing major restoration work in the areas were these same sanitation lines cross the Country Club; and

WHEREAS, the City will be able to perform these repairs at this opportune time without causing undo damage to private property or inconvenience to the Country Club's operations; and

WHEREAS, performing these operations at this time will reduce the burden to the City by lessening the amount of restoration required; and

WHEREAS, although this project was not budgeted for the 2008 fiscal year, the City Council desires to commence the necessary improvements during 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:




