April 16, 2013: Introduced as Council Bill 6, Series 2013 by Councilor Scott Roswell, seconded by Councilor Klasina VanderWerf and considered in full text on first reading. Passed by a vote of 5 yes and 0 no.

May 7, 2013: Considered in full text on second reading. Passed by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
AMENDING SECTION 6-3-110 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
CONCERNING SECURITY GUARD LICENSE RENEWALS**

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village is a home rule municipal corporation organized in accordance with Article XX of the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City regulates and licenses security guard businesses in the City according to Article 3 of Chapter 6 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to amend the Municipal Code regarding renewal of security guard licenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:


Section 1. That Section 6-3-110 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended:

Sec. 6-3-110. License renewal.

In order to renew a license prior to the expiration of the license, a renewal application shall be completed and submitted to the City on forms provided by the City ~~a new, complete application must be received by the City at least thirty (30) days prior to such expiration~~, to be processed in accordance with Section 6-3-70 of this Article.


