

Crime Prevention Tip: Mail & Package Security

Residents are being warned that there has been an increase of mail and package thefts throughout the Metro area to include the City of Cherry Hills Village. The Police Department recommends the following safety tips for securing your mail and packages:

- Retrieve mail from your mailbox as soon as possible and never leave items in your mailbox overnight or for extended periods of time. If you are going on vacation, either put a stop mail order in with your local postal service or have someone you trust pick up your mail daily.
- Install a locking mailbox that is United States Postal Service approved.
- Have packages delivered to your work place or sent to a relative or neighbor who is usually at home during the day. You may also consider having the package held at the delivery service that you use such as Federal Express or United Parcel Service.
