Sec. 11-2-220. Construction and excavation standards.

- (a) Each permittee shall comply with the Construction and Excavation Standards for all work in the public right-of-way, including the location of the work and facilities within the public right-of-way.
- (b) Except as otherwise provided in this Article, the permittee shall be fully responsible for the cost and actual performance of all work in the public rights-of-way.
- (c) All restoration shall result in a work site condition equal to or better than that which existed prior to the work.

It is the responsibility of the permit holder to call UNCC @ 811 for utility locates prior to performing any excavation allowed under this permit.
