ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF A  
NON-MOTORIZED RECREATIONAL TRAIL EASEMENT

WHEREAS, the property owner at 21 Sandy Lake Road approached the City about making the non-motorized recreation trail easement that traverses their southern property line a consistent width on their property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that a consistent width of eighteen (18) feet across the entire length of the property would continue to provide adequate and safe use of the non-motorized recreational trail easement across the entire length of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to accept the offered non-motorized recreational trail easement on the property located at 21 Sandy Lake Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby accepts a non-motorized recreational trail easement more specifically described in the attached "Easement Exhibit."

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately.
