**CALL TO ORDER**

Co-Chair Schmidt called the meeting to order at 10:13 a.m.

**ROLL CALL**

Co-Chair Dave Schmidt, and Commissioners Della Patteson, Christine Fedorowicz and Ann Marie Morrow were present on roll call. Also present were Emily Black, Parks Project & Operations Manager and Monica Castillo, Parks Clerk.

Absent: Co-Chair Pamela Hall, and Commissioners Kristen Moore and Sarah Anderson

**AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION**

There was no audience participation.

**CONSENT AGENDA**

Co-Chair Schmidt moved, seconded by Commissioner Patteson, to approve the following items on the Consent Agenda:

- a. Approval of February 27, 2023, Minutes

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- a. John Meade Park Sculpture and Fundraising

Manager Black reported that City Council approved the contract for two of the sculptures (with the third contingent on fundraising) and accepted the anonymous \$40,000.00 donation. She invited the Commission to discuss the upcoming fundraiser.

The Commissioners made the following decisions about the April 26<sup>th</sup> fundraiser:

- Only the maquettes would be auctioned; there would be no other items like tickets or homestays.
- Bidding for the maquettes will start at \$2,500.00.
- Bidding increments should be specified on the bid sheet, but the amount has not been determined yet.

## RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

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- Commissioner Federowicz will create an example plaque showing the names of donors that can be displayed at the event; attendees can be encouraged to donate to add their names to the plaque.
- Commissioner Morrow suggested giving a small gift to attendees and mentioned she has a monarch butterfly that you place in a book and when you open the book it flies out. She also asked about the Art Commissions stickers or magnets with the logo which is good for a small gift and include flower seeds or milkweed seeds which is a native of Colorado.
- Commissioner Patteson will reach out to Commissioner Anderson to get a to-do list for the auction.
- Manager Black mentioned as of today, we have only received six RSVP's.
- Co-chair Schmidt will reach out to Russell Stewart.
- Commissioner Patteson will reach out to Diane Vigoda who loved the Owl sculpture.

Manager Black will:

- Send the invitation list and the liaison list to the Commissioners so they can follow up with their invitees and Council/PTRC members.
- Invite Consultant Kendall Peterson to the fundraiser.
- Invite Artist Joe Norman to the fundraiser and find out if he has videos or slideshows of other work that can be displayed, and if there are sketches related to the "Resilience" series that can be auctioned.
- Remind the Parks, Trails, and Recreation Commission to RSVP.
- Email the Commission on Friday with an updated RSVP list.

### NEW BUSINESS

#### a. Interview Questions for Future Commissioners

Manager Black reported that at their February 7<sup>th</sup> meeting, City Council expressed a desire to provide more Commission involvement in the interview process for new commissioners; Council directed staff to work with each Commission to create interview questions that are specific to that commission's responsibilities; Council members will interview potential candidates using the provided questions from each commission. She explained that CHVAC should brainstorm 5-10 possible interview questions that Council members can ask of potential candidates to determine how suitable they are specifically to the Art Commission.

Commissioner Morrow suggested questions including:

- What is your attitude about public art?
- What art in the city do you appreciate now?
- What do you think your contribution will be to the Commission?
- Are you knowledgeable in fine arts?

The Commission agreed to consider additional questions at the next meeting.

### REPORTS

Manager Black reported that she received an email from the company that cleans the bronze sculptures in the park; they will be out in late May to clean the sculptures in addition to the sculpture at Quincy Farm.


She noted that the next CHVAC meeting is April 24, 2023.
