Co-Chair Schmidt welcomed Kendall Peterson of ThereSquared, LLC, via zoom to discuss a sculpture for John Meade Park. He shared that he likes the "Monarch Girl" sculpture that is pictured in the meeting packet.

Ms. Peterson shared that Joe Norman is a great artist and she described his sculptures as being large pieces out of cut steel and low maintenance. She said the "Monarch Girl" is 6 feet tall, but the artist said he could do an 8-foot sculpture within the Commission's budget. She said he could also do a series of three for around \$90,000.

Ms. Peterson suggested that once the Commission comes to a consensus about this artist they should move forward with the following steps:
