CALL TO ORDER

Co-Chair Hall called the special meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

CONSENT AGENDA

Co-Chair Hall moved, seconded by Commissioner Patteson, to approve the following items on the Consent Agenda:

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

John Meade Park Permanent Sculpture

Coordinator Black explained this was an opportunity for the Commission to discuss the proposal from Artist Joe Norman for a series of three sculptures for John Meade Park ahead of the Oct. 27th fundraising event.

Consultant Kendall Peterson reminded the Commission that this was a preliminary proposal from the artist, and this was the group's opportunity to provide feedback for him.

Following discussion, the Commission discussed moving forward with:

- 3 sculptures rather than one large version
- 6 ft. height
- Using a low plinth for the sculptures
- Asking if the artist can mellow out the blue and green colors somewhat (e.g. sky blue rather than royal blue; spring green rather than neon)
- Making the hummingbird sculpture more gender-neutral/androgynous
- Asking if there were other animals that the artist may have considered and exploring possibilities there

Commissioner Fedorowicz suggested using Instagram to promote the sculptures and having more fundraising events in the future.

The Commission discussed creating a video to share of the artist and the meaning behind the sculptures.

Commissioner Patterson suggested using plantings around the sculptures to expand the education component.

Commissioner Anderson proposed connecting with the Cherry Hills Land Preserve about fundraising.

Consultant Kendall Peterson recommended using the Oct. 27th fundraising event as an opportunity for community input.
