

**A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
ADOPTING THE 2021 ARAPAHOE COUNTY, COLORADO,
MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, natural hazards in the Denver region historically have caused significant disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, under the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, an adopted Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village adopted its designated portion of the Denver Regional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan through Resolution 7, Series 2005 and approved updates to the plan through Resolution 4, Series 2011 and Resolution 45, Series 2015; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 Arapahoe County, Colorado Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan continues the work of the Denver Regional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan by developing a county-wide hazard mitigation plan in accordance with FEMA requirements set forth in 44 C.F.R. Section 201.6; and

WHEREAS, City staff have fully participated in the planning process on the City's designated portion of the Plan, and the City Council desires to adopt the 2021 Arapahoe County, Colorado Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado that:


Section 1. The City of Cherry Hills Village hereby adopts the 2021 Arapahoe County, Colorado Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, a copy of which is available on the City's website and in the Community Development Department, 2450 E. Quincy Avenue, Cherry Hills Village, Colorado.

Section 2. The City of Cherry Hills Village will submit this Resolution to the Arapahoe County Office of Emergency Management to enable the Plan's final approval.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.

of June, 2021, by a vote of 4 yes and 0 no.




