A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
SUPPORTING THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL PARKS AND
OUTDOOR RECREATION GRANT FROM THE STATE BOARD OF THE
GREAT OUTDOORS COLORADO TRUST FUND FOR THE COMPLETION
OF JOHN MEADE PARK DESIGN AND PHASE I CONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village ("City") supports the City's Great Outdoors Colorado ("GOCO") grant application for John Meade Park Design and Phase I Construction as more fully described herein; and

WHEREAS, the City has submitted an application seeking grant funds in the amount of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000) from Great Outdoors Colorado (the "Application") to fund John Meade Park Design and Phase I Construction (the "Project") to improve John Meade Park, a park centrally located in the City, to and provide outdoor recreational opportunities for the public; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, the City Council supports the completion of John Meade Park Design and Phase I Construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Council strongly supports the Application and has appropriated the matching funds for such grant with Great Outdoors Colorado.
- <u>Section 2</u>. If the Application is approved and the grant is awarded, the City Council commits to the completion of the Project.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The City Council authorizes the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of any grant awarded.
- Section 4. The Project site (known as John Meade Park) is owned by the City and will continue to be owned by the City for the next twenty-five (25) years.
- <u>Section 5.</u> The City Council recognizes that as the recipient of a Great Outdoors Colorado Local Government grant, the Project site must provide reasonable public access.
- <u>Section 6.</u> The City Council will continue to maintain John Meade Park in a high quality condition and will appropriate funds for maintenance in its annual budget.
- Section 7. If the grant is awarded, the City Council hereby authorizes the Deputy City Manager/Public Works Director to sign the grant agreement with Great Outdoors Colorado.
- Section 8. This resolution is in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
