

**A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
SUPPORTING BALLOT QUESTION 2G TO AMEND THE HOME RULE CHARTER
TO CLARIFY WHEN THE ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING WILL OCCUR
FOLLOWING A REGULAR CITY ELECTION**

WHEREAS, voters approved a Home Rule Charter amendment in the April 2012 regular City election to move regular municipal elections to November of even-numbered years and to have elected officials (Mayor and City Council) assume the duties of office at the first regular Council meeting in January following the election; and

WHEREAS, currently Sections 3.3, 3.7 and 6.1 of the Charter refer to an organizational meeting on the Monday after the election at which the Mayor Pro Tem is selected and city staff is appointed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to initiate amendments to the Charter in order to amend these sections of the Charter to correct discrepancies between when officials are elected and when they take office; and

WHEREAS, if the voters do not pass ballot question #2G and the Charter is not amended, officials elected in November will be instructed by one section of the Charter to assume duties in January but by other sections of the Charter to carry out duties the Monday following the election; and

WHEREAS, if ballot question #2G is approved by the voters these discrepancies in the Charter would be rectified and the timing of the organizational meeting at which newly elected officials assume the duties of office following a regular city election would be clarified.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby supports ballot question #2G and urges **A YES VOTE** at the November 4, 2014 coordinated election.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
