**A RESOLUTION  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE  
CONCERNING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.1 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter authorizes the City Council to “delegate to board and commissions... such functions, powers and authority of the City as it deems proper and advisable”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cherry Hills Village Art Commission was established by Resolution 6, Series 2011 and expanded by Resolution 10, Series 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Elaine Asarch will be ending her first partial term on the third Tuesday of July 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Asarch has expressed her desire to be reappointed to a first full three-year term; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to reappoint Commissioner Asarch to a three-year term on the Cherry Hills Village Art Commission.
