**A RESOLUTION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE
CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF A NEW MEMBER
TO THE QUINCY FARM COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the City of Cherry Hills Village City Charter authorizes the City Council to “delegate to board and commissions...such functions, powers and authority of the City as it deems proper and advisable”; and

WHEREAS, the Quincy Farm Committee was established by Resolution 10, Series 2015 and amended by Resolution 12, Series 2015 and Resolution 7, Series 2018; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 7, Series 2018 increased the number of voting members from five to seven; and

WHEREAS, the Quincy Farm Committee has had a vacancy since that time; and

WHEREAS, applications to serve on the QFC were reviewed by Mayor Pro Tem Earl Hoellen and Councilor Randy Weil; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Pro Tem Hoellen and Councilor Weil have recommended that the Council appoint Joel Sydlow to the Quincy Farm Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE THAT:




