AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, VACATING A TRAIL EASEMENT ON THE CHERRY HILLS PARK I SUBDIVISION PLAT

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village accepted dedication of a sixteen-foot wide (16') recreational trail easement via the Cherry Hills Park I subdivision plat recorded with the Arapahoe County Clerk & Recorder on August 28, 1997 (Reception No. A7107627), and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village by approving the Cherry Hills Park I, 3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment plat has accepted dedication of another sixteen-foot (16') wide recreational trail easement that is in the same general location and performs the same function, and

WHEREAS, the City has held a duly noticed public hearing to determine whether the sixteen foot (16') wide recreational trail as originally dedicated on the Cherry Hills Park I subdivision plat is necessary for public use and convenience.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sixteen-foot (16') wide recreational trail easement shown on the Cherry Hills Park I subdivision plat (Arapahoe County Clerk & Recorder Reception No. A7107627) shall be vacated upon the recording of this Ordinance with the County Clerk for the County of Arapahoe after recordation of the Cherry Hills Park I, 3<sup>rd</sup> Amendment plat.
