February 20, 2001: Introduced as Council Bill No. 3 Series of 2001 by Doug Tisdale, seconded by Bonnie Blum, and considered by the title only on first reading. Passed unanimously.

March 30, 2001: Considered in full test on second reading. Passed unanimously. Designated as Ordinance No. 4, Series 2000.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO,
VACATING A TRAIL EASEMENT ON THE CHERRY HILLS PARK I SUBDIVISION
PLAT

WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village accepted dedication of a sixteen-foot wide (16') recreational trail easement via the Cherry Hills Park I subdivision plat recorded with the Arapahoe County Clerk & Recorder on August 28, 1997 (Reception No. A7107627), and


WHEREAS, the City of Cherry Hills Village by approving the Cherry Hills Park I, 3rd Amendment plat has accepted dedication of another sixteen-foot (16') wide recreational trail easement that is in the same general location and performs the same function, and

WHEREAS, the City has held a duly noticed public hearing to determine whether the sixteen foot (16') wide recreational trail as originally dedicated on the Cherry Hills Park I subdivision plat is necessary for public use and convenience.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHERRY HILLS VILLAGE, COLORADO, ORDAINS:


Section 1. That the sixteen-foot (16') wide recreational trail easement shown on the Cherry Hills Park I subdivision plat (Arapahoe County Clerk & Recorder Reception No. A7107627) shall be vacated upon the recording of this Ordinance with the County Clerk for the County of Arapahoe after recordation of the Cherry Hills Park I, 3rd Amendment plat.

Adopted as Ordinance No. 4, Series 2001, by the City Council of the City of Cherry Hills Village, Colorado, the 20TH day of March, 2001.



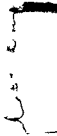
